Dear Parents/Carers,

You will have recently received a letter outlining the trips running during Enrichment Week 2020 (13-17<sup>th</sup> July). I am pleased to announce that after the huge success of the sports tour to Italy last year we are planning on running the same trip during Enrichment Week 2020. We will be once again staying at the Bella Italia EFA village in the resort of Lignano Sabbiadoro, a purpose built self-contained sports resort with international standard sports facilities including 4G pitches, Olympic pools and a private beach. This trip is open to all students in years 7, 8 & 9 and not just those who play in school teams. In addition to professional coaching sessions (football and basketball) we will also be taking part in various water sports activities, and going on a trip to the local water park.

We will leave Church Stretton School on the morning (approx 8am) of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and return during the evening of the Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July (approx 10pm). The cost is £630 (based on 35 persons) which includes:

- Travel to and from the Luton Airport
- Return flights
- Coach transfers in Italy
- Full board en-suite accommodation
- 2 Professional coaching sessions ( football and basketball)
- 2 Water sports activities (choice from sailing, wind surfing, canoeing or stand up paddle boarding)
- Visit to Aquasplash water park
- Evening entertainment
- Use of all the facilities onsite including the pools, slides and private beach

Historically this trip has been oversubscribed, if this is the case again this year we will complete a draw for places and also run a reserve list. Alternatively, there may be an increase in price if we do not hit our target of 35 students and we reserve the right to cancel if there are insufficient numbers.

If you would like to book a place for your son/daughter on the Sports tour please make a payment of £150 (non – refundable) via ParentPay by Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October.
